

U.K. Veterans – One Voice Good Friday Parade

With over 1000 people confirmed and more been added daily this is going to be the biggest and best event that uk veterans – one voice has hosted to date.

The GOOD FRIDAY AGREEMENT was signed in 1998 to bring an end to the troubles in Northern Ireland meaning our parade on Good Friday is symbolic.

We will be meeting at Northumberland Avenue at 11.00 hrs on the 25th March 2016 and will be setting off for Downing Street at 12.00 hrs under the orders of our RSM.

The Parade will be lead by our piper and will be followed by over 1000 members consisting of both ex military and civilian personnel.

Once we reach the cenotaph outside Downing Street we will be halted by our RSM so we can lay wreaths to remember our fallen brothers and sisters. We will then hold a 2 minute silence with the last post been played by our bugle player.

We will then enter Downing Street to hand in our letter demanding that the government put measures into place to protect and care for the veteran community.
