What we are doing

1. Bringing to the attention of anyone that will listen, the vilification of serving and retired Armed Services Personnel in the form of ‘special commissions’, various police forces and law enforcement authorities, courts and quango’s that seek to prosecute service personnel for ‘crimes’ allegedly carried out in the performance of their duties.
2. Creating a site uniting all groups where veterans can ‘go’ for help and advice on understanding what is happening and in particular addressing the needs and support for anyone suffering with PTSD
3. Creating a Telephone Service accessible for all suffering from PTSD, to be managed by trained members for effective support and care.

Why we are doing it

To prove the inappropriateness of such investigations, that civilian groups should not be in a position to deal with them, the inhumanity of such investigations, the inability for a ‘fair’ trial, to mention a few, and the fact that it will severely hamper the effective operation of force engagement in future ‘conflict’ situations and bring into question the very rock of commitment that service personnel swear an allegiance to in ‘joining up’.

What we have done so far

1. November 2015 – group set up
2. November 2015 – online petition started and reached 25000 signature
3. November 2015 – First official March to 10 Downing Street of over 250 retired personnel to hand in the petition
4. December 2015 – Dates for future marches Q1 2016 agreed
5. January 2016 – Marches in London and Belfast – Letter of concern handed into 10 Downing Street
6. Protest camp at Whitehall wef Jan 5th 2016

Outcomes we want to achieve

1. An immediate stop to all forms of service personnel harassment and potential prosecution
2. A release of already imprisoned service personnel
3. An enquiry into the accountability of Government members with regard to the approving of enemy engagement and the deployment of service personnel with unclear agendas or specific attributable outcomes.
4. An appreciation that the enemy of today is different to that many personnel are trained to attack
5. A proper support mechanism and programme for all veterans, serving personnel and associated forces suffering with PTSD

Our campaign plan for 2016

- Tuesday 5th January 2016 -LONDON - March to 10 Downing Street
- Letter for immediate cessation of legal/criminal case prosecutions
- Request for immediate release of all jailed personnel
- UK Media Coverage – Daily Mail
- Launch initiative to bring together all groups looking for information and help with PTSD
- Question – who is paying the lawyers – every case is getting Legal Aid
- Championing local MP's with the letter
- More marches -Belfast - Edinburgh
- Work with all groups looking for justice – eg Sgt Blackman
- Target all known defence spokespersons House of Commons
- Speakers Corner – posters and demo – PM questions day – Nigel Kelsall?
- Advertising – service magazines/daily papers/ etc
- Rally – stands at shows -
